

The Role of Qatari Women: Road to 2022 .

1- How would you describe the role of women in Qatari society?

Women have a prominent role in the State of Qatar. They compete with men in the highest administrative and scientific positions and have made a significant effort through their contribution in various fields inside and outside the Qatari society.
